“Global Open Courses” is offered by various faculties.

- ★ More than half of the classes are accepted even freshmen.
- ★ Small sizes class
- ★ Certificate of completion will be issued, if you meet the condition.

● Enrollment Procedure

Read carefully the enrollment guidance (履修の手引き) ; such as Student Handbook, with the following notices, and register your proposed classes within designated period by following the instruction of your Faculty Office.

● Notices for Enrollment

- You have to attend the 1st class and gain enrollment permission. In case of exceeding capacity, selection may be conducted.
- Make sure to read the syllabus in advance, in particular, pay attention to the prerequisite and the other conditions to enroll.
- Check class information carefully; such as Classroom change, Homework, etc. by each faculty bulletin board given the class.
- In case of taking other campus classes, your faculty's classes on the same day are not allowed to enroll. Confirm enrollment guidance (履修の手引き) carefully.
- If you take ILAC classes, confirm the destination of credit certification from ILAC board and Hosei WEB Syllabus.
- Some of the Fall semester classes are required to enroll during spring semester. In this case, students who start from fall semester are not allowed to enroll.
- Enrolling the classes given by faculties mentioned below, you need to meet one of the following minimum standards of English proficiency:
 - Intercultural Communication : TOEFL® iBT 61-75, TOEFL® ITP Level 1 500-539, TOEFL® ITP Level 2 500, TOEIC® 675-819, IELTS 6.0, and EIKEN Grade Pre-1st
If you don't have any score mentioned above, contact the instructors directly.
 - Global and Interdisciplinary Studies (GIS) : TOEFL® iBT 80, IELTS (Academic Module) band 6.0, TOEIC® 860, and EIKEN Grade Pre-1st (Required CSE Score 2450 since 2016)
Some courses need the higher English proficiency mentioned above.
 - Ichigaya Liberal Arts Center (ILAC) : TOEFL® ITP 430 or other equivalent English score are required ;
English Academic Writing I / II, English Presentation I / II and English Reading and Vocabulary I / II
TOEFL® iBT 61 is required ; Intercultural Communication B, C and D.
- “Design Basics in English” will be held at Ichigaya Tamachi Building.
- The credits of Global Open Courses are included among Maximum Allowable Number of Credits in Registration in each year.

● Certificate of Completion
