




# When your current period of stay is expiring soon

**(or already expired)** It may take up to 2~4 months for the screening at the Immigration Bureau. Even if your period of stay expires during this time, you can continue to stay in Japan with your previous status of residence for 2 months (or whichever is shorter until you get a new card) after the expiration (= special period), but please take the following actions.

Item	Necessary action
<b>My Number Card</b> *mandatory to holders 	<p>Even if you are renewing your period of stay, your My Number Card will <b>automatically expire at the current period of stay</b>.</p> <p><b>【When before the current period of stay】</b>            If your current period of stay is about to expire before you receive your new residence card, <b>be sure to contact the city office before it expires to confirm what you need to bring for a temporary extension of your My Number Card and then go and apply</b>.            Once your My Number Card expires, it will take about one month to reissue and a fee of about 1,000 yen.            When you receive a new residence card, please go to the city office again the next day or later to renew your My Number Card.</p> <p><b>【When after the current period of stay】</b>            Even during you are waiting for permission to renew residence (= special period), your My Number Card is already automatically expired. After the expiration date, you cannot apply for a temporary extension, so if you want to continue using your My Number Card in the future, you will need to apply to the city office for a <b>reissuance</b>. Please contact the city office to confirm what you need to bring and then apply after the next day you get a new residence card. Reissuance takes about one month and costs a fee of about 1,000 yen.</p>
<b>National Health Insurance</b> *mandatory 	<p><b>You will no longer be eligible for National Health Insurance at the current period of stay.</b></p> <p><b>【When before the current period of stay】</b>            If your current period of stay is about to expire before you receive your new residence card, <b>be sure to contact the city office before it expires to confirm what you need to bring for a temporary extension of your National Health Insurance Eligibility and then go and apply</b>.  <b>Please also check with the city office what you need to do after receiving your new residence card.</b></p> <p><b>【When after the current period of stay】</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If you are using a Myna health insurance:              Since your My Number Card itself was automatically expired, please contact the city office about Myna insurance when applying for a reissuance of your My Number Card.</li> <li>• If you are not using a Myna health insurance:              From December 2, 2024, a new Health Insurance Card will not be issued anymore due to the transition to a Myna health insurance.              A "Certificate of Eligibility" will be issued free of charge, but the procedure differs depending on the municipality. Please contact the city office.</li> </ul>
<b>Bank</b> *mandatory 	<p>If your current residence card is registered with your bank, your account transactions may be restricted after the registration period has passed. If your period of stay is about to expire before you get a new card, we recommend that you contact your bank to let them know that you are renewing your stay. <b>Once you get a new residence card, update your registration information.</b></p>
