Application Guide for the Volunteer Program Co-sponsored by FPT University

Hosei University will co-host an international volunteer program to work on local environmental problems and to support Japanese education for Vietnamese students. The program lasts for about four weeks, and is run with FPT University, our partner university. It was established with the aim of cultivation of human resources by the FPT Corporation, the largest information technology (IT) company in the country. Under the program, participants work on two community projects under support and supervision of professional industry mentors.

* Participants will be staying at the hotel room shared by two students. During the program, 2-3 days will be spent with a Vietnamese host family in order to deepen understanding of Vietnamese culture.

NOTE: This program is eligible for the Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) scholarship (70,000 yen). However, applicants must have Japanese citizenship or permission to permanently reside in Japan (including special permanent residents). For details, please refer to the Japanese version of the application guidelines.

[Qualification] Applicants must satisfy all the following requirements:

1. Communication skills in English or the local language of the destination (TOEIC 550 or more)

*Communication skills in the local language would be desirable but are not essential.

- 2. Applicants must be able to participate in all of the explanatory meetings and review seminars designated by Hosei University and FPT University before and after the internship program.
- 3. Consent of a guarantor for the application/participation

4. Passport must be valid for at least 6 months from the departure date.

*New or renewed passports must be obtained by the date of interview.

- 1. **<Documents>** Prepare a copy of your student ID, language certificate, and passport (scanned data PDF of the original).
- 2. **<Essay>** Download the application form data from Global Education Center website below and enter your answers to each item. Please also check the website for the format for submission. http://www.global.hosei.ac.jp/programs/oncampus/volunteer internship/
- 3. Use the application form below to answer the questions and submit the required documents (described in "1") and application essay (described in "2"). https://forms.gle/Q3GKFq7tMmilocm86

* < Note > You can't apply for more than one program in the spring of 2024

*Make sure to submit the Application Essay as a Word file.

- *Application documents and essay must be prepared by yourself. If any misconduct is discovered, such as using corrected sentences or using content created by others (including generative AI, etc.), the applicant will be disqualified.
- *Those who are currently participating or planning to participate in an overseas program (SA program, etc.) at Hosei University should confirm in advance with the Global Education Center regarding their eligibility to apply for this program.

[Note] Be sure to confirm the following before submitting your application:

- 1. Participants are not allowed to visit countries other than the destination on the way to or back from the program.
- 2. Participants must purchase air tickets designated by the university for the purpose of risk control.
- 3. Participants must take out overseas travel insurance designated by the university.
- 4. In case of cancellation, you will be charged with an amount equivalent to the actual costs claimed by the co-host (FPT) at that point.
- 5. Participants must sign a pledge before departure.
- 6. Participants must submit a report in a predetermined manner.
- 7. Read the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' safety information concerning security of your destination and the precaution statement of the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare quarantine station for infections and other health hazards.
- 8. Participation in the program may be terminated if a participant engages in any act that is illegal or offensive to public order and morals.
