How to apply to the Tokyo Immigration Bureau

As soon as all the required documents are ready, go to the Shinagawa office or your nearest branch to submit them. It may take up to 2~4 months for the screening at the immigration bureau.

You can check the access to the Shinagawa office and other branches from the URL below.

*You can apply to any branch office if the local government where you are registered as a resident is listed in the branch office's "area of responsibility." https://www.moj.go.jp/isa/about/region/tokyo/index.html



For changing to "Designated Activities – Job hunting-" before graduation, make sure to apply at the Shinagawa Office because other branches may not accept the "certificate of expected graduation".
