

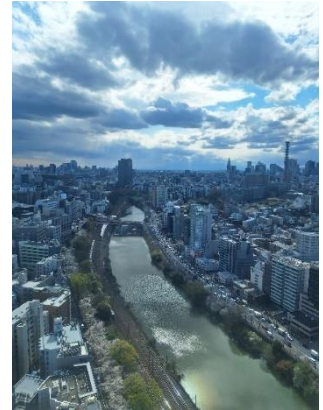
The Everyday Surprise of Life in Japan
