

### ■Orientation for First-year Students

On Ichigaya and Tama campus, information sessions on studying overseas and international exchange were held for first-year students. 540 students came, almost three times as many as last year when the event was held online. Further, on Tama campus, the student group FiTus organized a campus tour and an exchange event with incoming international students. Professors' academic advice, the university's counselor's introduction of the counselling unit, and the Japanese language professor's introduction of the Japanese language classes composed the substantial orientation for new students on Koganei campus.



### ■Winners of the Japanese Speech Contest Visited Hosei University

On March 20, winners of the "Hosei University Japanese Speech Contest" from Vietnam visited Japan. The speech contest started as part of the SGU project, to provide opportunities for students to show the results of their hard work in learning Japanese and to enhance our university's presence in Vietnam, which is a target country for the recruitment of international students. Visitors include not only this year's winners, but also winners of 2019 – 2020 who could not make the visit due to the Pandemic. They stayed for four days with an itinerary that included paying respects to the President, enjoying a campus tour of Ichigaya, meeting international students in the university and so on. It is hoped that the visitors would become even more interested in Japan and consider studying at Hosei University.

The competition entered its 7<sup>th</sup> year last academic year.
