		Fund-raising for Agent Orange Victims Center	After completing the products, students will carry out fundraising by bringing the items back to the FPT University campus to sell to Vietnamese, Japanese, and other international students. From the funds raised, students will give them to the children of Agent Orange victims. Set up a vibrant booth where Vietnamese and international students come together to showcase and sell unique products, handmade crafts, and cultural souvenirs, fostering cross-cultural connections and creativity!
		Volunteer at Environmental organization (CORMIS)	Explore social enterprises that transform recycled fabrics into beautiful handcrafted products, creating job opportunities for local women in need of extra income. Get involved by contributing innovative product ideas to appeal to Japanese tourists.
