As a part of supporting the creation of a super global university, we implemented the Global Point System in 2015. This system awards students with points for participation in programs specified by the university, such as overseas exchange programs and language training programs, which students can then use to monitor their activities and use them for their future studies.

Students who actively participate in various programs and earn a specific number of points will be honored as role models in our university's vision of a super global university.

System Structure

- 1 Participate in a program that is eligible for points
- 2 Apply online for the program you participated in within the application period
- 3 The Global Education Center checks your application details and awards points.
- 4 Honor the students who have earned a specific number of points

Following courses are eligible for points!

- Overseas exchange programs and short-term language training
- International volunteer and internship
- ESOP and ERP courses
- Global open courses

Applicant Eligibility Details



- Must have completed one of the following programs sponsored or co-sponsored by the university.
 - *Program registration or attendance only are not eligible for points.
- The eligible period is **from April 1, 2024 (Monday) to March 31, 2025 (Monday)**.
 - *Based on the date of completion of the program (scheduled date of completion)

Faculty-specific study abroad programs and overseas training programs (1month or more)	5	per program
Study abroad programs organized by NOT the university (1month or more) (*1)	5	per program
Faculty-specific study abroad programs and overseas training programs (less than 1month)	3	per program

*1: A written proof of completion of the program must be submitted at the time of application.

*2: Presentation does not have to be at an international conference hosted or co-hosted by Hosei University, and it can be held in Japan or abroad. Only presentations that are known to your supervisor or the university administration are applicable. An international conference is defined as one that uses a foreign language. For example, the conference may be conducted in English only or two languages such as Japanese and English. Conferences with an international theme that are conducted only in Japanese are excluded.

*3: Support of international symposiums and other events refers to the support for the operation and implementation of international symposiums, international lectures, lectures with overseas speakers or panelists, and joint programs with embassies and other foreign organizations that Hosei University has sponsored or co-sponsored.

Award Winners

Earned 10 points or more during the above period

A certificate of commendation from the university will be given to eligible students. Additionally, the top 10 students who earn 10 points or more will receive a commemorative gift.

*Eligible students will be contacted separately regarding the award.

Earned less than 10 points during the above period

Applicants with less than 10 points will be awarded 2 points in the following academic year at the time of application for their active participation in global programs every academic year (the same applies to those with 10 points or more).
