



English Holiday Programme

In these unprecedented times, educational holidays are confined to our homes. Fueled by the need to keep students learning, the English Holiday Programme has transitioned to remote online learning, allowing learners to ‘travel’ virtually by taking up online English classes in Malaysia. Modelled after UCSI University’s English for Tertiary Education Programme (R/KJP/00920-00929), this is a short, intensive course which immerses learners in an interactive, lively, and motivating environment while studying English from the comfort of their own homes.

Through this programme, learners will be able to practice their usage of spoken and written English as well as grammar and vocabulary to complement their English language learning experience. Learners will also get the chance to make friends with language learners from all over the world while improving their English reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills. Our teachers are highly qualified and will help learners build their confidence as well as their English proficiency.

1. Entry Requirements

Aged 16 years and above, all learners are required to sit for the English Placement Test (EPT).

2. Intakes

3. Course Outline

The course aims to develop learners' fluency and accuracy when communicating in English by focusing on the application of the language (listening comprehension, speaking, reading comprehension, and writing).

This is done by exploring various contexts where English is used in formal and informal social situations. A practical approach will be used where learners will be engaged in various context in which the target language will be introduced and applied, along with structure and vocabulary.

Before learners join our online classes, they are carefully assessed by means of a placement test, so that the appropriate level of study may be assigned to them. Our courses progress through eight levels of academic study, from 'Beginner' to 'Level 3'. Within each level, learners are tested by various methods in order to provide a system of monitoring student understanding and eligibility for progression to the next level of study.

The table below clearly explains the levels that are offered under the English Holiday Programme.

A Certificate of Attendance will be issued at the end of the programme to candidates who fulfilled at least 80% of the attendance requirement.

4. Application Procedure

Anyone can enrol in the English Holiday Programme, which is currently conducted virtually.

To apply:

- Submit the registration form online via <https://forms.gle/YQykaZc4fgnJBftY7> to the Registry at Centre for Languages;
- Submit a copy of the first page of a valid passport or an Identity Card (IC), both sides;
- Pay the prescribed fee, and sit for the English Placement Test (EPT).
