Global Open Courses 2023 (グローバル・オープン科目)

"Global Open Courses" is offered by various faculties.

- ★ Conducted in English
- ★ More than half of the classes accept even freshmen.
- ★ Small sizes class
- ★ Certificate of completion will be issued if you meet the conditions.

•Enrollment Procedure

Read carefully the enrollment guidance(各学部の「履修の手引き」), such as Student Handbook, especially about the following points, and register your proposed classes within designated period by following the instruction of your Faculty Office.

•Points regarding Enrollment

- You have to attend the 1st class and obtain enrollment permission. If the class capacity is exceeded, selection may be conducted. However, for Liberal Arts Courses, complete temporary class registration on the Learning Management System before class begins.
- · Make sure to read the syllabus in advance; in particular, pay attention to the prerequisite(s) and any other conditions on enrollment.
- · Check Hoppii or web bulletin boards of each host faculty of the class carefully for class information, such as classroom change, homework, etc.
- ・Note that you are not allowed to enroll in classes held on a different campus if you are enrolled in your faculty's classes on the same day. Confirm enrollment guidance(各学部の「履修の手引き」) carefully.
- · If you take ILAC classes, confirm the destination of credit certification in the enrollment guidance of your own faculty.
- · Some of the Fall semester classes require enrollment in the spring semester. In this case, students who start from Fall semester are not allowed to enroll.
- · To enrol in the classes given by faculties mentioned below, you need to meet one of the following minimum standards of English proficiency:

Global and Interdisciplinary Studies (GIS)

TOEFL®iBT 80, IELTS (Academic Module) band 6.0, TOEIC® 860, and EIKEN Grade Pre-1st (Required CSE Score 2500)

Some courses need a higher English proficiency than the above mentioned scores.

Intercultural Communication TOEFL® iBT 61-75, TOEFL® ITP Level 1 500-539, TOEFL®ITP Level 2500, TOEIC® 675-819, IELTS 6.0, and

EIKEN Grade Pre-1st. If you don't have any of the scores mentioned above, contact the instructors directly.

Ichigaya Liberal Arts Center (ILAC) TOEFL® iBT 61 is required;

Intercultural Communication B, C and D.

TOEFL® ITP 430 or other equivalent English score are required;

- · "Design Basics in English" will be held in the Ichigaya Tamachi Building.
- The credits of Global Open Courses are included among Maximum Allowable Number of Credits in Registration in each year.

•Credit Limit and Handling of Credits by Faculty

Credits earned in Global Open Courses are counted toward the credits required for Graduation in many faculties. Be sure to check each faculty's "Course Guide" for details regarding approving credits and requirements for graduation and promotion. At the time of course registration, Global Open Courses are included in the maximum number of credits allowed per year, just like other specialized courses.
